

OPCAT visit to the Nagymágocs Castle Home of the Integrated Care Center in Csongrád County

On September 12-14, 2017, the staff members of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism, one staff member of the Department for Equal Opportunities and Children's Rights and two external experts paid a visit to the Nagymágocs Castle Home of the Integrated Care Center in Csongrád County.



The visit was aimed at examining the living conditions and treatment of the elderly residing in the institution. Members of the visiting delegation inspected the premises of the institution, conducted interviews with the personnel and the residents. The medical treatment and medication of the elderly were checked by a medical expert, catering to the residents was inspected by an expert dietician.
